

Scholarship application form

Tatachilla Lutheran College offers scholarships in seven categories, including General Excellence (Years 4-7); Academic Excellence (Year 10); Science and Mathematics (Year 10); Advanced Athletics (Year 10); Arts (Year 7-10); Ecological Stewardship (Years 7-10); and First Nations (Years 7-12).

All scholarship recipients, regardless of scholarship type, receive a 25% discount on their college tuition fees for a period of one academic year. Recipients may re-apply for a scholarship for the subsequent academic year, noting that scholarship recipients may only hold one scholarship at any one time.

Children of college staff are ineligible to apply for a scholarship.

This form may be used to apply for more than one type of scholarship, noting that a \$50 nonrefundable administration fee will be charged for **each scholarship category** for which an applicant wishes to be considered.


