BUS CODE OF CONDUCT

Students are requested to regard their use of school buses as a privilege and respond accordingly.

- Students should arrive at the designated pick up at least 5 minutes earlier than the designated pick up time and ensure that they are visible to the driver.
- Students are required to hail the bus to stop by placing their hand out as the bus is approaching.
- Students are required to present a valid ID Card/Keyfob for use on the electronic Busminder system each time they catch a bus.
- Eating and drinking on buses is prohibited.
- Students are required to remain seated while on the school buses.
- Where seat belts are provided they must be worn at all times.
- The school bus is an extension of the school environment, and students are expected to adhere to the same behaviour expectations as they would in the classroom. This includes respecting the bus driver, other students, and property.
- Inappropriate behaviour on the bus will be responded to in accordance with the College's Behaviour Support Guidelines and may result in a place on the bus being withdrawn.
- The cost of any damage caused to the bus during travel will be charged to the student or his/her family.

These conditions and expectations if supported and followed by all students will ensure a happy and caring environment on TLC bus services, and allow the driver to transport students to and from the College in a safe manner. This, in part, is the purpose of the service.

Students who refuse to follow these conditions and expectations can expect consequences in line with the College behaviour management policy. Ultimately any student who refuses to follow the Bus Code of Conduct will be permanently excluded from using the service and may also be excluded from the College.
