

What will my child's day look like if the College transitions to the Remote Education Plan for a school closure longer than three days?

If the College is forced to temporarily close, the community will transition to the Remote Education Plan. The Remote Education Plan will only be activated for a closure of the school for longer than three days.

Junior School

Parents/caregivers should look at Seesaw for home learning tasks and communication details. Students can expect a selection of activities that will cover literacy, numeracy and integrated units of study.

Teachers will offer a live Zoom session for student check in and greetings at times as scheduled (voluntary participation).

Teachers will include a daily good morning/welcome video by 9am on Seesaw. Parents/caregivers can confirm attendance by 'liking' the teacher's daily online welcome video indicating their child is commencing their learning.

Students are to wear their College sport uniform when online in Zoom and face to face online learning experiences. They should also be in a common family area of the home such as the kitchen table area, lounge or study/office area (not bedrooms/bathrooms) due to Protective Practices legislation.

Middle School

SEQTA is the central location for the storage and access to curriculum information for students and parents.

There will be a daily Zoom session with Home Class Teachers at 8.40am. Teachers 'check in' with students via Zoom on regular occasions.

Students to follow the teaching and learning of their courses through the lessons on SEQTA, including the provision of opportunities to ask questions and receive responses.
