Drum kit skills are essential, while tuned percussion experience is advantageous. Experience teaching to AMEB grades is desirable, as is experience supporting students to complete solo and ensemble tasks associated with the College classroom for SACE students. Applicants are required to support the Lutheran ethos and values and support students to participate in College ensembles where appropriate.
